

Guardian Auto Glass Network Limited Warranty

Guardian Auto Glass Network provides a limited warranty for the following:

Stationary Glass Parts

What is Covered:

Any Guardian manufactured defect in the glass or any leaking or other defect related to the installation of stationary glass parts (does not apply to problems associated with body damage or rust).

For How Long:

For as long as you own the vehicle.

What Will Guardian Do:

Repair the defect or replace and reinstall the stationary glass part at no cost to you.

Moveable Glass Parts

What is Covered:

Any Guardian manufactured defect in the glass or a defect of workmanship or leaking related to the installation of moveable glass parts (does not cover: rubbish-removing vehicles, off-road equipment and off-road vehicles).

For How Long:

For 90 days from the date of installation.

What Will Guardian Do:

Repair the defect or replace and reinstall the moveable glass part at no cost to you.

Windshield Chip Repair

What is Covered:

Any crack or run from the original point of repair of your windshield (as identified in the diagram below).

For How Long:

For as long as you own the vehicle.

What Will Guardian Do:

Apply the amount you paid for the original chip repair of your windshield toward the replacement cost of a new windshield purchased from and installed by Guardian Auto Glass Network.

How to Get Service: Present this limited warranty at the Guardian Auto Glass Network location from which you received service or call 1-800-662-4544 to locate a Guardian Auto Glass Network outlet near you.

Limitations: The remedies described above are the only remedies provided by Guardian Auto Glass Network. This limited warranty does not cover any incidental or consequential damages. Any warranties implied by law are limited in duration to the applicable time periods set forth above. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, and some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above exclusions or limitations may not apply to you.

Your Rights Under State Law: This limited warranty give you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights that vary from state to state.
